FORMER NBA PLAYER TO SPEAK AT GEMS OPENING CEREMONY; PRE-REGISTRATION OPEN ON-LINE



Tim McCormick, a former NBA player who now provides analysis on ESPN and for ABC college basketball, will speak at the opening ceremony for Glass Expo Midwest™ (GEMS), which will be held in Grand Rapids, Mich., October 9-10, at the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel & DeVos Place.
